

ACTIVITIES OF SPORTS AND CULTURAL INSTITUTIONS IN MIRISHKOR DISTRICT

Abstract

During the years of independence, attention to the sports and cultural sphere has increased in all regions of Uzbekistan. Important reforms in this area have also been carried out in the Mirishkor district of the Kashkadarya region. This article presents the potential of the district in the sports and cultural sphere, the results achieved, and the specific aspects of the cultural life of the district.

Introduction

On May 6, 2003, the evening in memory of Honored Artist of Uzbekistan T. Murodov and the regional competition of maqom groups and senior singers were held at the Jeynov collective farm. The Karshi district "Chol chamani" folk song and dance ensemble and the children's maqom ensemble under the Shahrisabz Palace of Culture took 1st place in the competition, the Guzar district "Khushruiy" folk song and dance ensemble took 2nd place, and the Mirishkor district "Gozal" song and dance ensemble took 3rd place.

In order to find talented young people in the district, improve their creativity, and spend the residents' time productively, the modern, fully equipped Children's Music and Art School No. 3, 6 cultural institutions, including the Palace of Culture in the towns of Yangi Mirishkor, Jeynov, and Pomyk, and the village of Chandir serve as a place for meaningful leisure, spirituality, enlightenment, and art for the population, especially the youth [1].

A culture and recreation center, 2 parks of culture and recreation, 2 stadiums, 15 sports fields, a children's and youth sports school, and a children's school "Barkamol Avlod" are also operating.

In accordance with the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated December 31, 2020 No. 820 "On measures to further develop the family institution and prepare young people for family life", the next training sessions were held at the center for preparing young people for family life in Mirishkor district. The participants were trained by the head of the Family and Women's Department Z. Mamanazarova, head of the Medical Association B. Muhammadjonov, head of the FSDYO department S. Hidirnazarova, and the head of the center for preparing young people for family life N. Nuryogdiyeva.

The training course provided lessons for future brides and grooms on issues such as the spiritual and moral foundations of family relations, legal relations, family economics, household and budget management, social environment in the family, marital relations, healthy lifestyle, gender issues, harmonization of family relations and prevention of conflicts, culture of communication, socio-psychological factors of a happy, strong family.

As a first step in the systematic preparation of people getting married in family legal relations and increasing their legal literacy, training in "Family Legal Relations" was introduced. The reason is that those getting married should understand that they are on the threshold of a new legal status, and the rights and obligations imposed on them by the Law after they receive the status of husband or wife. If couples accept the legal status with a sense of responsibility, family psychology, health, economics and family budget, and spiritual and moral values will also yield the expected results.

In 2022, the republican stage of the table tennis competition within the framework of the second season of the Five Initiatives Olympiad was held in Namangan region. 100 participants took part in the final stage held at the "Pahlavon Mahmud" sports palace and competed in 3 age categories. According to the final results of the "V" league, Amonov Tolib, a resident of the "Oqmachit" neighborhood, took an honorable 2nd place in the republic in the table tennis category for 22-26 years old and received a 2nd degree diploma, valuable prizes and a certificate worth 200 million soums for the construction of a workout sports ground for his neighborhood. Also, among girls aged 16-21, Aliyeva Dildora Tursunpolat kizi took 3rd place in the region. Among girls aged 22-26, Toychiyeva Nodira Farhod kizi took 1st place in the region. Among girls aged 27-30, Toychiyeva Zebiniso Farhod kizi took 2nd place in the region. Among boys aged 27-30, Toychiyev Jaloliddin Farhod oğlu took 1st place in the region. Deputy district governors Anvar Sarikov and Ulash Choliyev presented the athletes, their coach and youth leader with gifts from the district governor.

The acting head of the Mirishkor district department of the Youth Affairs Agency Rajabkulov Abrorjon, the specialist on "5 Initiatives" Fayzullayeva Indira, the employee of the Mirishkor district of the department Mukhriddin Boymurodov, the youth leaders of the "Obod" and "Barhayot" neighborhoods were awarded with commemorative badges "30th Anniversary of the Constitution of Uzbekistan". At the award ceremony held in the youth center of Karshi, the head of the regional department of the agency Temur Poyonov presented the badges.

The chief specialist of the Committee for Religious Affairs in Mirishkor district F. Asadov and the head of the district department of the RMMM Kh. Karomatov were awarded with commemorative badges "30th Anniversary of the Constitution of Uzbekistan".

The final stage of the "Prosecutor General Cup" competitions within the framework of the "Five Initiatives Olympics" in wrestling was held. In December 2022, our young wrestler Jasurbek Taganov, a resident of the "Tinchlik" MFE in the town of Pamuk,

became the absolute champion of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the "Cup of the Prosecutor General" in the 90 kg weight category at the national wrestling tournament. At the national wrestling tournament organized in Pamuk, district khokim Sherali Sanayev, head of the Internal Affairs Directorate Musurmon Boriyev, and first deputy khokim Khurshid Sharopov were awarded letters of gratitude from the head of the National Guard Department Umid Azimov for their active involvement in attracting young people to regular physical education and sports, and for their active participation in promoting a healthy lifestyle in society.

In the village of Gulistan, a multi-sport competition dedicated to the adoption of the Constitution on December 8 was held. More than 100 famous riders from local and neighboring regions participated in this competition.

On Sunday, December 11, 2022, the "IBSA Judo Tokyo Open Tournament" international open judo competition among the blind was held in Japan, the country of the sun. The national champion from Mirishkor, Shohruh Mamedov, who participated in this competition, defeated all his rivals in the 73 kg weight category and became the World Champion. The head of the district awarded 15 million soums in prize money and valuable gifts. Due to the attention paid to youth sports in Mirishkor district, 5 world and 5 national champions have been achieved. In 2022, 47 athletes from Mirishkor took honorable places in national, Asian and world competitions. In particular, five young world champions, two winners of international competitions, and three Asian champions. Two young people also took 2nd place and two took 3rd place in the Asian competitions.

Five athletes in the district became national champions. Also, 16 took honorable places in the championships of Uzbekistan, and two became owners of the Cup of Uzbekistan. The district has produced world champions such as Mukhtorali Murtozayev, Nodir Samandarov, Sherbek Azamatov, Sarvar Roziyev and Shohrukh Mamedov.

The championship was achieved in competitions in the following sports: Taekwondo ITF, Usmanov combat systems, Uzbek martial arts, table tennis, karate, kurash, judo, Wushu sanda and parajudo.

On December 17, 2022, the district division of the Republican Center for Spirituality and Enlightenment, the district division of the Youth Affairs Agency, the district Department of Culture, and the Children's Music and Art School No. 21 in the district jointly held the district stage of the Republican Competition "My Contribution to the Development of the Motherland". This competition was held in three directions:

1. Fine and Applied Arts,
2. Literature and Journalism
3. National Status and National Variety, and the winners who won first places in these directions received a ticket to participate in the regional stage of the competition.

In Mirishkor district, a series of events have been launched to organize meaningful leisure activities for young people under the slogan "Our initiative, our talent, our strength - for the Motherland" until March 20, 2023. The event was organized in cooperation with the district administration, prosecutor's office, department of the State

Security Service, department of internal affairs, youth affairs department, sports department and culture department, and competitions in national wrestling, Uzbek martial arts, table tennis and chess began.

At the initiative of the Mirishkor district division of the Republican Center for Spirituality and Enlightenment, a training seminar was held in the field with the participation of deputy directors for spiritual and educational affairs of all schools in the district. It gave a number of instructions on the implementation of the President's resolutions No. PQ-3160, PQ-4307 and PQ-5040. During the seminar, a number of opinions and comments were expressed by industry workers with many years of experience. At the end of the seminar, a group of spiritual workers who were active in the spiritual and educational field were awarded with commemorative gifts by the Mirishkor district branch of the Republican Spirituality and Education Center [2].

In February 2023, the 539th anniversary of the birth of Zahiriddin Muhammad Babur was widely celebrated in Mirishkor district. The Republican Spirituality
